That Otunba Olutola Senbore of Olutola Senbore & Co, an experienced Liquidator, evaluated, approved and endorsed by the National Council on Privatization through its Secretariat, the Bureau of Public Enterprises is hereby appointed as the Liquidator of Nigerian Mobile Telecommunications Limited (MTEL).
3. That there shall be no order as to costs.
